Open savannahs allow enriched off-roading and night drive experiences. Seasonal mokoro rides will navigate the Delta waterways, and the venerable woodlands of Maboia Island wait to be discovered on safari walks — all at an affordable price point.

The Kwara Private Reserve

Wildly varied landscapes and action-packed game viewing



Sharing precious permanent waterways with Moremi Game Reserve in the east to the vast savannah plains and ancient forests of Maboia Island in the west, this game-rich reserve sits on the northern edge of the Okavango Delta and is well-known for consistent predator sightings.

Healthy lion prides, cheetah coalitions, African wild dogs, and herds of elephants ramble the reserve, as well as giraffe, sitatunga and hippos. The sightings success rate is thanks to overlapping of several habitat types. Kwara is blessed with extensive grasslands, palm-tree-lined landscapes, abundant floodplains, and deep channels with rich riverine forest snaking deep into the Delta. For bird-lovers at Splash Camp or Kwara Camp, there's the intriguing Godikwe heronry. Accessed via a scenic boat trip, this unique seasonal site heaves with storks and thousands of other water birds, breeding, nesting and feeding. To savour the small species, there's the unrivalled freedom of a walking safari on Maboia Island at 4 Rivers Camp.
