Riverfront Predator Paradise

*The Kwando Wildlife Experience at it's original best. This camp is where it all began. Spend the morning following African wild dogs on a hunt, and by evening, cruise the river on the double-decker boat as the sun sets.*



## WHERE ON EARTH?

One of the largest private wildlife reserves in the world. Kwando Private Concession spans 232,000 ha / 573,300 acres in the far north of Botswana.

Lagoon airstrip is roughly 15-min drive from camp. Light aircraft flight approx 50-min from Maun or Kasane.

Lagoon and Lebala camps can be combined with a free of charge vehicle transfer. It's a thrilling 3hr route traversing scenic, game-rich areas.

## SAFARI ACTIVITIES

All hosted by Kwando's iconic guide and tracker teams. Departure times and duration tailored to season, sightings and guest interests

### Game Drives

- Off-road tracking
- Night drives
- Vehicles with enhanced features: USB ports, comfortable drop-down ladder access, storage between seats, adjustable padded armrests as extra support for long camera lenses
- Photographic beanbag supports available on request
- Roof canopy removed at guide's discretion or guest request when circumstances allow
- Max. six per vehicle for guaranteed window seat

### Nature Walks

- Off-road on-foot with specialist walking guides

### Boating

- Seasonal, best during flood season (April to September)
- Fishing during open season (Mar to Dec)

## THE CAMP

Located on the banks of the tranquil Kwando River – and at the heart of the wildlife action – Lagoon takes safaris seriously, with many a vantage point for nature lovers.

### Facilities

- Spacious open-sided dining, lounge and bar areas below thatched roofing, elevated library and riverfront firepit area
- Raised viewing deck and romantic swing overlook the Kwando River
- Swimming pool overlooking the Kwando River
- Safari shop. Manual card authorisation only; cash payments in ZAR, GBP, USD, EUR and BWP
- Complimentary laundry service (no delicates)
- Solar power with backup generators

### Fully Inclusive Food and Drink

- Light breakfast around the fire before morning activity, tea and coffee bush break, brunch afterwards, high tea before each afternoon activity with snacks and sundowners, dinner on return
- All menus and mealtimes accommodate sightings
- Communal dining is standard, with indoor and outdoor dining options
- A water fountain, soft drinks, local beers, and spirits, plus a wide selection of South African red, white and sparkling wines are included. Specific wines and spirits can be requested in advance (at an extra cost)

## ACCOMMODATION

Rooms lie in ancient riverine forest overlooking Namibia's Zambezi Region, where the rumbles of hippos resonates all year round.

### The 8 Tented Suites and 1 Family Suite all have:

- Elevated, private viewing deck with outside seating
- Spacious lounge areas with armchairs, tea and coffee facility, charging station (international multiplugs), writing desk
- Open hanging space and shelving for clothes, digital safe, spare blankets, ceiling fan within mosquito net, insect repellents and an emergency horn
- En-suite, flushing toilet, double vanity basins, ball-and-claw bathtub, indoor and outdoor showers, gowns, hot and cold water supply
- All rooms can be configured as a double (super-king, extra-length bed) or a twin (two ¾ beds, extra-length beds)
- Plug charging points suitable for sleep apnea machines but not hair dryers
- Lighting always available
- Yoga mats available on request

### Family Friendly

- Family suite comprises standard en-suite tent (with outdoor shower) connected to a smaller room sharing one bathroom with a separate toilet
- Min. age is 6. Families travelling with children aged 6-11 years must book private activities
- Walking for children 12yrs+
- Extra bed available allowing for three children in family tented suite or, if family suite is booked, a child in a standard tented suite
- Special bush activity program for children and early mealtimes on request
