Classic-style Safari Camp
OKAVANGO DELTA

Ebbing waterways of the Gomoti River feed luscious grasslands, and support critical dry season watering points, so game-viewing is great year-round. Favoured by old bachelor buffalo herds, there is often exciting predator interaction.



WHERE ON EARTH?

The Gomoti River in the south of the Dinare Private Reserve (NG34) bordering Moremi Game Reserve in a game-rich concession of 27,115 ha / 67,000 acres.

The Sankuyo community directly benefits from each safari. Over 60 employees at the Dinare camps are from the nearby Sankuyo village, and further proceeds support local development (such as household water connections and solar power).

Santawani airstrip is roughly 45-min drive from camp. Light aircraft flight approximately 20-min from Maun and 1h20 from Kasane. 3hr road transfers and self-drive from Maun available too.

SAFARI ACTIVITIES

All hosted by Kwando's iconic guide and tracker teams. Departure times and duration tailored to season, sightings and guest interests

Game Drives

- Off-road tracking
- Night drives
- Photographic beanbag supports available on request.
- Roof canopy removed at guide's discretion or guest request when circumstances allow
- Max. six per vehicle for guaranteed window seat

Nature Walks

- Off-road on-foot with specialist walking guides

Mokoro

- Seasonal during high water levels, best between May and September

THE CAMP

The twin camps, Mma Dinare and Rra Dinare, are located 4km apart and are easy to combine for hosting groups and unforgettable celebratory events.

Facilities

- Spacious open-sided dining, lounge and bar areas below thatched roofing and raised firepit area
- Swimming pool
- Safari shop (card machine available and cash payments in ZAR, GBP, USD, EUR and BWP)
- Complimentary laundry service (no delicates)
- 100% solar power with backup generators

Fully Inclusive Food and Drink

- Light breakfast around the fire before morning activity, tea and coffee bush break, brunch afterwards, high tea before each afternoon activity with snacks and sundowners, dinner on return
- All menus and mealtimes accommodate sightings
- Communal dining is standard, with indoor and outdoor dining options
- A water fountain, soft drinks, local beers, and spirits, plus a selection of South African red, white and sparkling wines are included. Specific wines and spirits can be requested in advance (at an extra cost)

Special Requests

- Private meals, vegetarian, vegan and most dietary requirements catered for with advance notice

ACCOMMODATION

This relaxed camp gets the mood just right – spacious tents with every comfort are connected via wooden walkways through riverine forest at the edge of the Gomoti floodplains.

The 9 Tented Suites and 1 Family Suite all have:

- Elevated, private viewing deck with outside seating
- Spacious lounge areas with armchairs, ceiling fan, tea and coffee facility, charging station (international multiplugs and USB), writing desk, open hanging space and shelving for clothes, digital safe, spare blankets, mosquito net, insect repellents and an emergency horn
- En-suite, flushing toilet, double vanity basins, outdoor showers, gowns, hot and cold water
- All rooms can be configured as a double (super-king, extra-length bed) or a twin (two ¾ beds, extra-length beds)
- Plug charging points suitable for sleep apnea machines but not hair dryers
- Lighting always available

Family Friendly and Accessible

- Family tented suite comprises a standard en-suite tent (with one outdoor shower) connected to a smaller tent with its own en-suite bathroom
- Min. age is 6. Families travelling with children aged 6-11 years must book private activities
- Walking and mokoro for children 12yrs+
- Extra bed available allowing for three children in family tented suite or, if family suite is booked, a child in a standard tented suite
- Special bush activity program for children and early mealtimes on request
- Tent 5 has wheelchair-friendly toilet, and the camp has ramps to public areas
