

# NXAI PAN CAMP

Where Explorers Tread  
MAKGADIKGADI PANS

The only permanent camp in the Nxai Pan National Park, this safari is ideal for witnessing the Zebra Migration and visiting Baines' Baobabs as well as engaging with the time-honoured Bushmen traditions.



## WHERE ON EARTH?

Nxai Pan National Park, an extension of the vast, and surreal Makgadikgadi Salt Pan network.

Nxai Pan airstrip is roughly 15-min drive from camp. Light aircraft flight approx 40-min from Maun or 1-hour from Kasane.

4WD self-drive from Maun takes 3 hours and transfers available from the park gate.

## SAFARI ACTIVITIES

All hosted by Kwando's renowned guide and tracker teams. Departure times and duration tailored to season, sightings and guest interests. Activities restricted to national park opening hours with no off-road driving permitted.

### Game Drives

- Photographic beanbag supports available on request
- Roof canopy removed at guide's discretion or guest request when circumstances allow
- Max. six per vehicle for guaranteed window seat

### Baines' Baobabs Day Trip

- Visit Kudiakam salt pan and its island of ancient baobab trees where David Livingstone camped out on his expeditions and enjoy a picnic lunch

### Bushman-led Nature Walks

- Easygoing, immersive nature walks conducted near camp to learn about ancient San survival techniques, medical plants and more

### Experience the Zebra Migration

- Between December and March, summer rains bring thousands of zebra to the lush grasslands

## THE CAMP

Open-plan spaces and bleached decor inspired by the salt pans create a relaxing, harmonious atmosphere, and a raised deck provides unobstructed views of the waterhole, which attracts wildlife throughout the year. Closed during June.

### Facilities

- Spacious open-sided dining, lounge and bar areas below thatched roofing and firepit area with a spotting scope
- Swimming pool
- Safari shop. Manual card authorisation only; cash payments in ZAR, GBP, USD, EUR and BWP
- Complimentary laundry service (no delicates)
- Solar power with backup generators

### Fully Inclusive Food and Drink

- Light breakfast around the fire before morning activity, tea and coffee bush break, brunch afterwards, high tea before each afternoon activity with snacks and sundowners, dinner on return
- All menus and mealtimes accommodate sightings
- Communal dining is standard, with indoor and outdoor dining options
- A water fountain, soft drinks, local beers, and spirits, plus a wide selection of South African red, white and sparkling wines are included. Specific wines and spirits can be requested in advance (at an extra cost)

## ACCOMMODATION

Maximising on panoramas of the plains without compromising privacy, natural light floods into these airy rooms under thatch.

### The 8 Suites and 1 Family Suite all have:

- Private viewing deck with outside seating and clear view of the waterhole
- Spacious lounge areas with armchairs, ceiling fan, tea and coffee facility, charging station (international multiplugs), writing desk, open hanging space and shelving for clothes, digital safe, spare blankets, insect repellents and an emergency horn
- En-suite, indoor and outdoor shower, flushing toilet, double vanity basins, gowns, hot and cold water supply
- All rooms can be configured as a double (super-king, extra-length bed) or a twin (two ¾ beds, extra-length beds)
- Plug charging points suitable for sleep apnea machines but not hair dryers
- Lighting always available

### Family Friendly

- Family suite comprises standard en-suite unit (with outdoor shower) connected to a smaller room sharing one bathroom with a separate toilet
- Min. age is 6 (except 1 April – 15 November when there is no min. age) and families travelling with children aged 6-11yrs must book private activities
- Extra bed available allowing for three children in family tented suite or, if family suite is booked, a child in a standard tented suite
- Special activities offered for children and early mealtimes on request
