The real deal. Pom Pom's classic safari tents and stunning lagoon setting make this the quintessential Okavango Delta camp, often considered the best all-round offering in Botswana given its consistent game sightings.



WHERE ON EARTH?

The Pom Pom Private Concession (NG27A), west of the Moremi Game Reserve. Camp overlooks the lily-strewn Pom Pom Lagoon at the headwaters of the Xudum River system. Leopard particularly enjoy the woodland habitats.

Pom Pom airstrip is roughly 5-min drive from camp. Light aircraft flight approximately 20-min from Maun and 1h30 from Kasane.

SAFARI ACTIVITIES

All hosted by Kwando's iconic guide and tracker teams. Departure times and duration tailored to season, sightings and guest interests

Game Drives

- Off-road tracking
- Night drives
- Vehicles feature USB ports and photographic beanbag supports available on request
- Roof canopy removed at guide's discretion or guest request when circumstances allow
- Max. six per vehicle for guaranteed window seat

Mokoro

- Seasonal during high water levels, best during flood season (May to September) when trips depart from camp

Boating

- Seasonal, best during flood season (May to September) when trips depart from camp
- Fishing during open season (Mar to Dec)

Nature Walks

- Off-road on-foot with specialist walking guides

THE CAMP

A camp for traditionalists — rustic and real with an atmosphere of warmth and ease. Pom Pom conjures the safaris of old, where fireside storytelling and debriefing the day's exploits are as memorable as the game viewing itself.

Facilities

- Spacious open-sided dining, lounge and bar areas below thatched roofing and firepit area
- Swimming pool
- Safari shop (manual card authorisation only; cash payments in ZAR, GBP, USD, EUR and BWP)
- Complimentary laundry service (no delicatés)
- Solar power with backup generators

Fully Inclusive Food and Drink

- Light breakfast around the fire before morning activity, tea and coffee bush break, brunch afterwards, high tea before each afternoon activity with snacks and sundowners, dinner on return
- All menus and mealtimes accommodate sightings
- Communal dining is standard, with indoor and outdoor dining options
- A water fountain, soft drinks, local beers, and spirits, plus a selection of South African red, white and sparkling wines are included. Specific wines and spirits can be requested in advance (at an extra cost)

Special Requests

- Private meals, vegetarian, vegan and most dietary requirements catered for with advance notice

ACCOMMODATION

now with limited messaging and emails

Set around a hippo-filled lagoon, tented suites enjoy sweeping Delta scenery and abundant birdlife in the treetops above.

The 8 Tented Suites and 1 Family Suite all have:

- Elevated, private viewing deck with outside seating
- Lounge areas with armchairs, ceiling fan, tea and coffee facility, charging station (international multiplugs and USB), writing desk
- Open hanging space and shelving for clothes, digital safe, spare blankets, insect repellents and an emergency horn
- En-suite, flushing toilet, double vanity basins, gowns, outdoor shower, hot and cold water
- 1 Tented Suite features a romantic outdoor honeymoon bathtub
- All rooms can be configured as a double (king bed) or a twin (two ¾ beds)
- Plug charging points suitable for sleep apnea machines but not hair dryers
- Lighting always available

Family Friendly and Accessible

- Family tented suite comprises standard en-suite tent (with outdoor shower) connected to a smaller tent with its own en-suite bathroom
- Min. age is 6. Families travelling with children aged 6-11 yrs must book private activities
- Walking and mokoro for children 12yrs+
- Extra bed available allowing for three children in family tented suite or, if family suite is booked, a child in a standard tented suite
- Special bush activity program for children and early mealtimes on request
- Tent 2 has wheelchair-friendly toilet, and the camp has ramps to public areas.
